

NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS OF SCHOOL BUS REPLACEMENT PLAN
FOR THE YEARS 2010-2021

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of the Monroe County Community School Corporation that on September 15, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. at the Bloomington High School South meeting room located at 1965 S. Walnut Street, Bloomington, Indiana the School Board of Trustees shall conduct a hearing to consider the School Bus/Vehicle Replacement Plan as summarized below for the twelve (12) year period between 2010 and 2021. The levy required to fund this plan will be raised as indicated in the Notice to Taxpayers of Budget and Levies to be collected in 2010. Detail of the proposed plan is on file in the office of the Superintendent for inspection from the date of this notice. Taxpayers shall have the right to be heard on the plan summary as listed below at the public hearing.
